### Dear member of the family society,

The board of the family society has outlined the tasks and activities for the next two years. In 2013 the family society celebrates its 30 years' anniversary. The next family meeting takes place in the same year. Genealogical research is one of the main tasks of the society. The research will be emphasized in finding the forefathers of Eskil Piira on one hand and the genealogical contacts with the Piirainens/Piiroinens living in the area of Leppävirta/Heinävesi (Central-Finland) on the other hand.

As a start to this research the board decided to arrange a genealogical seminar together with researchers studying Piirainen/Piiroinen families in Leppävirta and Heinävesi. On the agenda of the seminar there will be connections between these families (in Kuhmo and Leppävirta) and different methods in finding information. The results of the seminar will be presented in a further seminar during the next family meeting in 2013.

The next family meeting and celebration takes place in summer 2013 in Kuhmo. The exact date will be stated later. Instead of the usual trip there will be a genealogical seminar. A committee was nominated for the arrangements of the meeting and the seminar.

# Trip to Viena Karelia in 2012 and to the USA in 2014

Next summer after Midsommer fest on June  $25^{th} - 28^{th} 2012$  we arrange a trip to the Solovetsky Islands and Monastery in the White Sea and to the village of Tsuba (N 66° 16' 30.02'', E 33° 03' 46.57''). These are the areas where the forefathers of Eskil Piira presumably carried on the business of making and selling salt. This four-day trip has expert guiding. The price of the trip is 515 €/person (those with own visa 440 €) and it includes hotel accommodation (3 nights), breakfasts and dinners mentioned in the program, ship trip to Solovetsky, visit to Sekirnaya Hill, guiding and group visa. Also the president or the vice president Jorma Piirainen give information. The first 20 persons are taken to the trip in entry order. Act now!

Our route goes through many interesting places known from the Finnish - Russian war in 1940 -1945 such as Rukajärvi, Kiestinki and Kiskis Hills. The road takes us also through Viena folklore villages such as Kalevala, Vuonninen and Vuokkiniemi. We also visit the town of Kostomuksha. Detailed program is at end of this paper.

For 2014 we plan a trip to the USA to meet our American cousins. The board decided to start studying the various possibilities for the trip. You will hear about them later.
