## Dear Relatives!

## Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> of July

We begun the starting ceremonies with greetings from the Huotari Family Society's chairman of the board Jorma Komulainen, who also gifted us with their standard.

The main lecturer of the day was Ari Kolehmainen from Mikkeli, who the Family Society has contracted for more family research. His work will be about Piira-family in Savo and North Karelia in the 1500' and 1600's. Plan is to publish the research in the Family Meeting of 2019. Kolehmainen's work is to complement our own researcher's, Jorma Piirainen's work from the aforementioned centuries.

In the afternoon we got to enjoy musical entertainment. In the Oli ilo -concert of the Sommelo-event performed kantele group from USA, led by Sarah Gummings. One of the players was Loraine Piirainen.

The day ended with vesper and revealing of the family memorial stone at Kuhmonniemi, photo inculded in the letter. The stone was brough from the Kiekinniemi yard, where it used to be a cornerstone. Same yard, where Eskil himself walked barefooted or in his birchbark shoes. We wanted to stone to commemorate both Suomi Finland 100 event and the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of birth of Eskil. Another historical moment for our Family Society.

## Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> of July

The morning went as scheduled. People came to the depositing the wreath on soldier's grave and the church. The sermon was held by Riikka Pääkkönen (nee Piirainen).

Next we got to enjoy some music by singer Risto Piirainen, accompanied by accordionist Pentti Karjalainen, who performed several times during that day. Also young dancers of Piirais-tytöt from Kuhmo and Sotkamo took the stage. The host of the event was Tapio Piirainen.

As a surprise number we got to hear old Kuhmo dialect from early 1900's, when Veikko Piirainen from Maine, USA sent his regards via video to us. Unforgettable moment. Thanks to Dale Piirainen, who brough us the message.

In the oration Jorma Piirainen, the honorary chairman of the board, spoke of Karelians of Tver and the Piira-family's connection to them. His clear presentation gave us a good picture of a minority's situation inside a big nation. Historical facts about battle, survival, success and continuing to live to this day.

Family Meeting went without a hitch. Members accepted the board's accounts and the action plan for 2017-2019. Some of these can be found on our web page.
